BIDDING PROCEDURES

Each person wishing to bid must be registered prior to the auction.

SILENT AUCTION

Use your assigned bid number (on the back cover of this booklet). Each new bid must be in increments of \$5 as specified on the bid sheet or the bid is void. **No bids may be made after the silent auction table is closed.**

If there is a challenge to a winning bid at the time a silent auction table is closed, the Silent Auction Judge will ask the person challenging the bid and the highest bidder to submit a Bid Challenge Form. This blind bid process requires each bidder to submit their one-time highest bid. Bidding in increments of \$5 still applies. The Silent Auction Judge will then review the blind bids and award the item to the highest bidder. Items will be available at check-out at the end of the program.






